

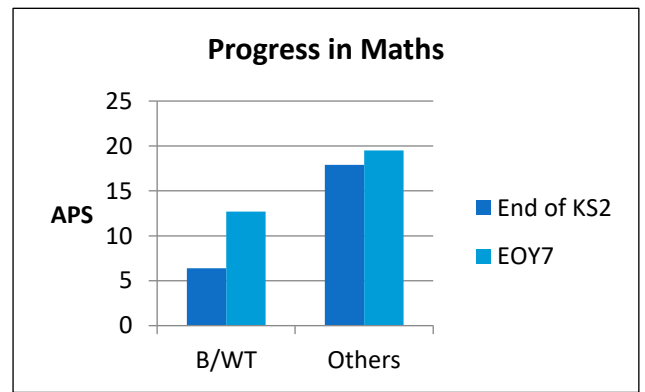
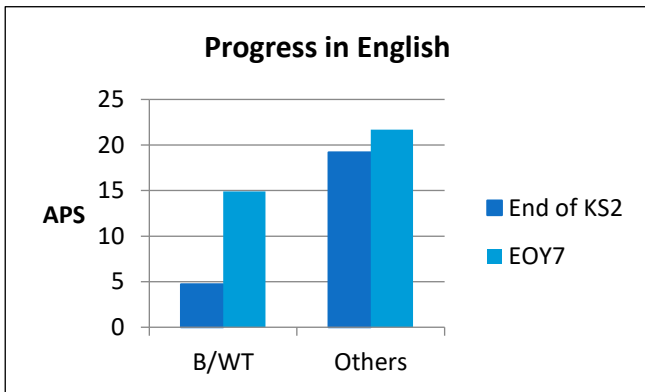
Catch-Up Premium 2018 - 19



Strategic Summary

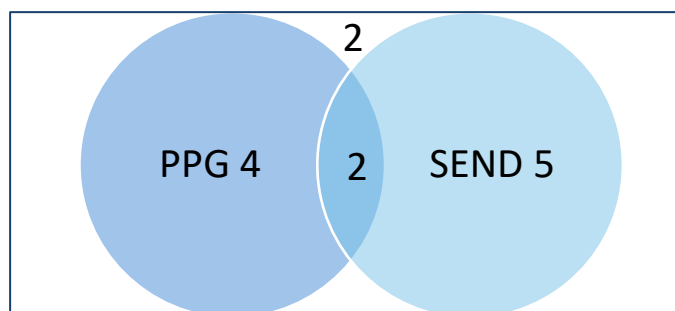
The Catch-Up Premium is given to the school to support Year 7 students who achieved below the National Standard at the end of Key Stage 2 in English and/or maths. Baseline testing in the first month of Year 7, using the Suffolk Reading test, enables us to further identify students with a reading age below age-related expectations, and students who need additional support with literacy and/or numeracy. We use the funding directly to accelerate progress in literacy and numeracy and close the attainment gap between students and their peers.

Students receiving Catch-Up Premium made an additional 5+ months of progress in reading during Year 7, and 10.2 average points of accelerated progress from the start of Year 7, compared with 2.5 points for other students.

Students receiving Catch-Up Premium made 6.3 average points of accelerated progress during Year 7 in maths, compared with 1.6 for other students.



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
