## Teaching priorities for current academic year

Priority 1	Additional teaching at KS4 – after-school, weekends, holidays – with focus on catching up for lost time on GCSE teaching
Priority 2	Enhanced teaching at KS3 – prioritising gaps in literacy and numeracy
Priority 3	Revision of computing curriculum to ensure students are able to complete online learning more confidently
Projected Spending	£25,000

## Wider priorities for current academic year

Priority 1	Year 11 Mentoring programme for 20 students, with most significant under-achievement
Priority 2	CAT assessments for Year 7 students to identify attainment on entry, and focus for intervention
Priority 3	Provision of online and paper resources (GCSEpod; Maths watch; Educake; Seneca)
Priority 4	Staff CPD - delivering remote learning; adapting curriculum to make up for lost learning; mastery teaching
Projected Spending	£21,000
